



There is no registration fee required to join. Eligible applicants will receive a notification of acceptance as non-regular students at USU for a limited period. At the end of the program, assessments will be conducted, and successful participants will be granted transferable credit units. Please read the registration process carefully.

1. For interested participants, please apply online through the registration link provided in each Summer Course program.
2. Local participants can register directly without any documents.
3. For international participants, specific documents must be provided as follows when you register.
  - a. Completed Application Form (in PDF format max. 300kb)
  - b. Curriculum vitae (in PDF format max. 300kb)
  - c. Scanned copy of ID page Passport (in JPEG format 100kb-300kb)
  - d. Latest close-up Digital colored Photo (Facing Front, Red Background, File size Between 100kb-300kb in JPEG format)
  - e. Letter of Declaration (in PDF format max. 300kb)
4. If international participants want to join offline activities, please provide the following additional requirements at least 6 weeks before the summer course starting date. Also, make sure your passport has a minimum of 6 months validity for the B211A Visa (the student visa required to join a short course)
  - a. Scanned Copy of Returned Ticket (in JPEG format 100kb-300kb)
  - b. Letter of Compliance (in JPEG format 100kb-300kb)
  - c. Scanned copy of passport cover (in JPEG format 100kb-300kb)
  - d. Scanned copy of complete Vaccine Certificate (in JPEG format 100kb-300kb)
  - e. Scanned Copy of Health Insurance/Travel Insurance (in JPEG format 100kb-300kb)
